## York University Info Guide

## Introduction:

York University is a public university located in Toronto, Ontario, Canada. There are 49,700 undergraduate students, including 11,000 international students from 178 countries, as well as 7,000 faculty and administrative staff. The student to faculty ratio is $1: 16$. The acceptance rate is $89 \%$. Please note all prices within this guide are in Canadian Dollars (CAD).

## Student Life:

Clubs: York offers over 350 extra-curricular activities for students to participate in! There are a variety of clubs, varying from science to medicine to law and politics.

Athletics: York offers over 450 intramural and competitive sports teams. Students have access to York's recreational facilities, which include: gyms, an indoor track, squash courts, swimming pools, tennis courts, ice rinks, and an indoor driving range. These sports teams compete with other local universities as well as internationally.

Greek Life: Unfortunately, sororities and fraternities are not given official designation by York, effective since 1990. However, York offers an alternative called "colleges."

## Colleges:

York colleges are a place to study, hang out, and make friends in a more intimate setting. Each student is assigned a college based on their program of study or residence. There are 9 different colleges:

York offers many mental and physical health services, including, but not limited to:

## Housing:

Housing is guaranteed to all first-year students who apply by the deadline.

## Keele:

${ }^{\circ}$ Keele has 8 buildings that house approximately 250 students each. They offer traditional, 2-person, and 6-person residences. They also offer common shared bathrooms and private bathrooms. Most residences are co-ed, however, there are same-gendered floors available.

## Glendon:

${ }^{\circ}$ Glendon offers two buildings with semi-private suites and self-contained community bathrooms.
Most residences are co-ed, however, there are same-gendered floors available.

## Rates (Keele + Glendon):

Rates range from \$7000-\$10 000 CAD for 8 months, depending on rooms.

## Meal Plan:

Depending on what building you stay in, meal plans are required. For students who live in residences with kitchens, meal plans are optional.

York offers numerous fast-food restaurants including:

## Global:

Summer Abroad Courses: York offers courses abroad in the summer. Courses are 4-6 weeks in length. The class sizes range from 15-25 students. The 2020 destinations and courses were:

- Greece - Modern Greek History
- China - Supply Chain Management
- Portugal - Visual Anthropology
- Germany - Berlin History
- Honduras - Animal Communication

Global Internships: These three-month non-credit global internships. To be considered, students must have a cumulative GPA of 6.0 (B) and must be senior full-time undergraduate students returning to York in the fall. Positions are unpaid, however, students selected will receive The York International Internship Award, providing a bursary of \$3000. York currently has Global Internship Agreements with 40 organizations in 25 different countries.

Global Exchange: York offers a global exchange program with 120+ partner institutions. To apply, a 6.0 overall GPA is required. Students can apply to exchange for one semester, or two semesters (one full academic year.) Students may be eligible for up to $\$ 1500$ in funding to cover costs.

## Locally:

Double Majors: York delivers a choice of over 100 major and minor degree options. York offers the opportunity to have a double major (and often in completely different career fields!)

Internships: York University offers numerous placements in a variety of fields, where students can integrate their classroom learning with hands-on, paid work experience. Internships typically last for 4,8 , or 12 months.

## Location \& Surrounding Area:

York has two campuses located in the Greater Toronto Area. They boast libraries, cinemas, studios, athletic facilities, and hundreds of lecture halls and classrooms. Students are welcome to take programs at each campus. Each campus has all amenities within walking distance of each other.

Downtown Toronto has an array of nightlife. There are restaurants, sightseeing, attractions, and special events to enjoy.

## Keele Campus:

${ }^{\circ}$ Keele boasts five libraries, 92 buildings, athletic facilities, residences, a shopping mall, and outdoor green spaces.
${ }^{\circ}$ Keele is home to many research centers, including the Sherman Health sciences research center and the life sciences center.

## Students applying from within Ontario (OUAC):

Base application fee: \$150. January is usually the deadline for programs, however, some program deadlines maybe earlier. Each program has its own course requirements so be sure to check OUAC to adequately plan.

## Students applying from elsewhere:

If you are applying from elsewhere, you can apply directly to York. The base application fee is $\$ 130$. Students can submit an application at any time.

## York Entrance Scholarship:

Bursary calculated based on average:
-95\% (42-45 IB Diploma Points): \$4000 (Able to be renewed for an additional 3 years.)
-90.94.9\% (36-41 IB Diploma Points): \$2500
-85-89.9\% (33-35 IB Diploma Points): \$1500
-80-84.9\% (30-32 IB Diploma Points) - \$1000

General Education Requirements While At York: The Cumulative Grade Point Average for all courses taken must be at least 5.0, with a Major GPA of 5.5. Students follow degree requirements based on years. Students must obtain at least 90-120 credits (depending on programs) to earn a diploma.
