Student Opportunities:

- Alfred University offers many different work study options for students

- Events like Hot Dog Days, and Alumni Weekend bring all of Alfred together
- Alfred University also boosts an equestrian center where all students can take classes no matter what major

- The Career Development Center (CDC) offers many programs like internships and career fairs for students
- AU has classes that range from discussing Harry Potter to the process of making maple syrup

Housing Options:

- Students are not required to live on campus and cars are allowed for Freshman
- Alfred University offers a variety of residences

Barresi Residence Hall

- Hosts 79 first year students
- Contains a large common area, large kitchen and an art showcase room
- Located at the north end of campus, it is next to Aide Dining Hall and minutes away from the McLane Center

Cannon Residence Hall

- Right next to Barresi Residence Hall the Cannon Residence Hall also hosts 79 students with two floors for men and one for women
- Contains single resident and two resident dorm rooms

Pine Hill Suites

- A group of 7 buildings that house upperclassman
- The buildings are separated into Upper Pine and Lower Pine
- Each building has ten suites with 6 students in each suite
- Each building has a lounge with a computer lab, a full sized refrigerator and billiards or ping pong tables

Moskowitz Residence Hall

- Hosts 99 residents
- Renovated in 2018
- Has a large game room and fitness large
- Closest to the Science Center and Aide Dining Hall
- Connected to the Link: a large common area that spans two dorm buildings

Tefft Residence Hall

- Hosts 99 students
- Mixed class: double and single occupancy rooms
- Contains floors to ceiling showers and a full kitchen

Bartlett Residence Hall

- Contains the Office of Residence Life
- Mostly Upperclassman and is only single occupancy rooms
- Has a large amount of international students and a large commonplace

Joel's House

- Hosts 22 students in a family like setting
- Isolated from the rest of the campus
- Has two outdoor decks and a foosball table

Ann's House

- Energy efficient housing that hosts 48 students
- Coed floors with a lounge on each floor and laundry facilities on the first floor
- Equipped with solar panels and outdoor compost

Openhym Residence Hall

- Hosts 150 students in double and single bed rooms
- Has the late night study lounge which is a study space for students to use after library hours
- Recently renovated in 2020

Ford Street Apartments

- Hosts 124 students within 6 units
- Contains 4 person apartments and 6 person apartments
- Hosts upperclassmen in an apartment environment

International House

- Hosts international students in a family like environment
- Contains one double bed and 12 single beds
- Has a game room and dining room with two full tables

Brick Residence Hall

- Hosts 98 students with handicap accessible options
- Contains mostly upperclassman (highly desirable)
- Was used as an infirmary during WWII and is on the National and State Historical Registry

Kruson Residence Hall

Hosts 98 students

- Is in close proximity to Herrick Library and Powell Campus Center
- Has a soundproof study area in the basement

Hillel House

- Home to a community of Jewish students
- Contains 5 single rooms and 2 kitchens (one kosher)
- Hosts many different cultural and social events

Honor House

- Is a residence for 5 students in the Honors program
- Hosts events that welcome students to the Honors program and the Death by Chocolate event
- Dedicated to the Honor program in 1994

Language House

- Reserved for upperclassman
- Hosts students that are studying different languages and hosts many language centered activities
- Has single and double beds

Environmental Studies House

- Hosts 6 students that are a part of the environmental studies program
- Students test environmental projects in the house
- Hosts environmental discussions and tutoring

Academic Strengths:

- As it contains the NYS College of Ceramics and has many strong art programs
- Alfred University also has a selection of engineering programs
- The psychology program at AU is beginning to grow as a bright spot for the University

Food on Campus:

- There are 5 different food options on campus: Aide Dining Hall, Powell Cafe,
 Starbucks, Midnight Express and Community Table
- Aide Dining Hall contains American food, a bakery, allergy free food and a Mongolian grill
- Powell Cafe has rice bowls, sandwiches, wraps, pizza and is a great place for lunch

- Midnight Express is a stop and go shop with the Met Grill
- Community Table is a great place to get catering from and host many events

Food off Campus:

- Collegiate Restaurant (The Jet): 0.4 miles from campus. Local dinner serving American and Western New York favorites
- Terra Cotta Coffee House: 0.4 miles from campus. A cafe that has freshly brewed coffee and great desserts
- Uncle Alfred's Sub Shop: 0.3 miles from campus. A classic sub shop with great subs and salads
- The Rosebush: 0.3 miles from campus. A high quality diner and bar in downtown Alfred. (Great place to take the parents when they are in town).
- Panda Chinese Restaurant: 0.4 miles from campus. Quick takeout American Chinese food.
- Little Sicily Pizza and Restaurant: 1.4 miles from campus. A pizzeria with great thin crust pizza and a variety of items

Stores in Town:

- Uni-Mart: 0.3 miles from campus. A classic convenience store in downtown Alfred.
- Dollar General: 1.3 miles from campus. Great place to get any essentials without having to travel far.
- TInkertown Hardware: 1.7 miles. A locally owned hardware store.
- Mobil: 1 mile from campus. Convenience store with a subway added on.
- The Roque Carrot: A local grocery store with a selection of fresh and local products

Transportation:

- AU offers a bus route multiple times a day to Hornell (a larger town with Walmart, Wegman's, Dunkin and Lowe's)
- Alfred University also has a bus from New York City to Alfred three times a day through Shortline
- Transportation is also provided through the Hornell Area Transit system with stops in Hornell, Dansville, and more

 AU also offers shuttle services from Greater Rochester International Airport and Buffalo Niagara International Airport

- The campus of Alfred University is on a hill so bring good walking shoes
- AU is a part of the Tuition Exchange program
- Students will tell you to take advantage of the many restaurants in downtown Alfred
