 - The University Career Services at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill offers access to all different kinds of internships for students year round

- Honors Carolina
 - High school students who would like to apply for the honors program at UNC will be prompted to indicate this on their application. After doing so you will need to write a short essay (250 words max) describing your academic interests and how you feel Honors Carolina will help you pursue those interests.
 - You will also need a strong letters of recommendation from a teacher and your counselor
 - Average High School Class Rank: Top 3-4%
 - Average SAT Score: 1450
 - If you don't get in you may reapply in January after completion of your first semester at UNC
 - Members can register for up to two honors courses
 - Other honors opportunities
 - If you have a minimum GPA of 3.3 at the completion of your junior year you can write a Senior Honors Thesis to graduate with Honors or Highest Honors (don't have to be in Honors Carolina to do this)
 - Students with a 3.0 GPA can participate in Honors Study Abroad programs
