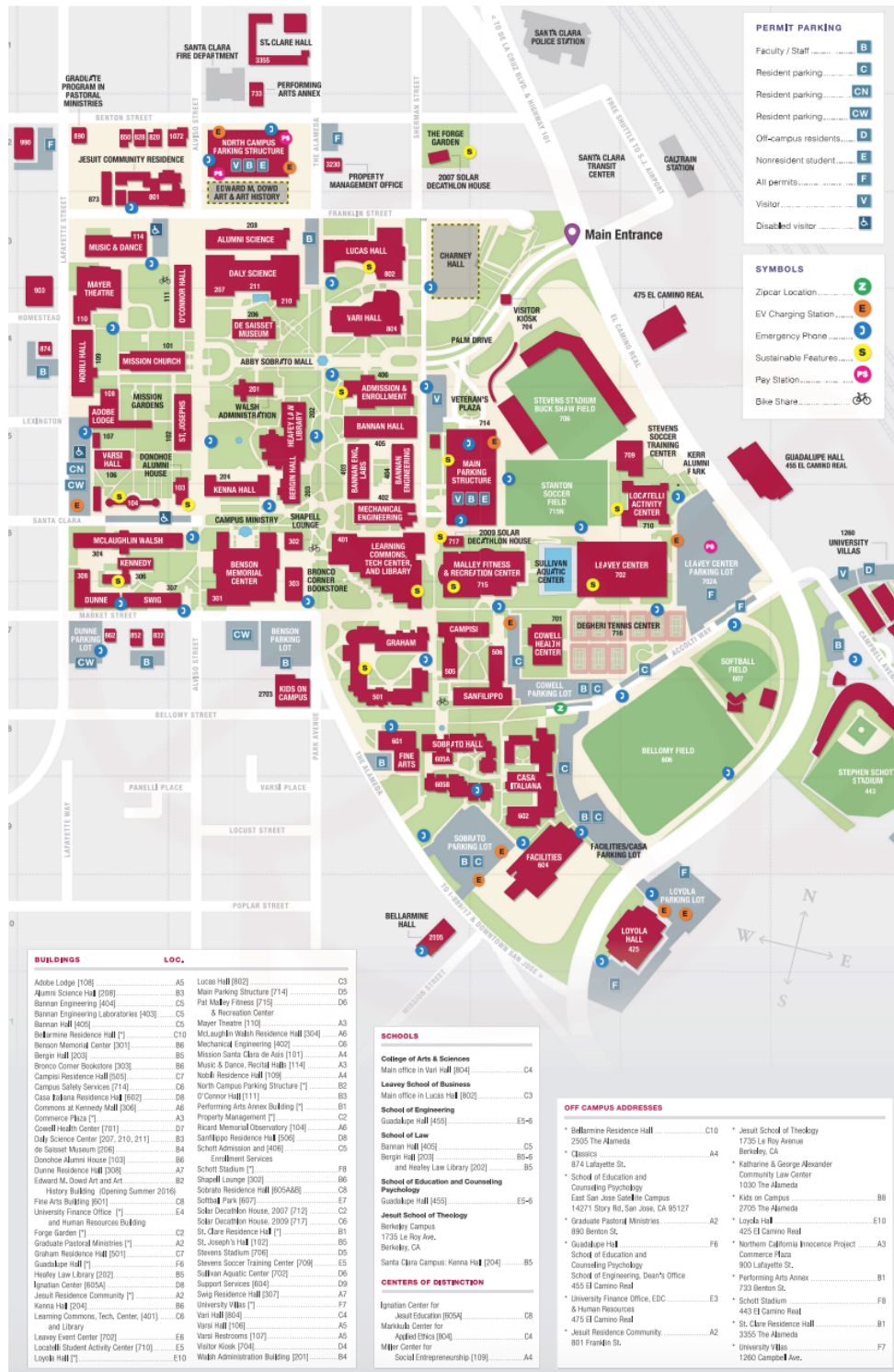
Complete Common Application

Official high school transcripts (grade nine through the most recently finished term)

- If your official high school transcript is in another language, submit the original and a translation into English.
- Santa Clara prefers transcripts uploaded electronically through Common Application or any other security software program by an administrator or school counselor.
- One Academic Teacher Evaluation (through Common Application)
- Secondary School Report Form (through Common Application)
- Mid-Year Report is due by January 31st—only candidates deferred from Early Action (through Common Application) or Regular Decision applicants
- \$70 non-refundable application fee

Academic Requirements for Graduation

- Obtaining a minimum of 175 quarter units for the bachelor of arts or bachelor of science in the College of Arts and Sciences (a minimum of 193 quarter units for engineering physics majors).
- Getting a minimum of 175 quarter units for the bachelor of science in commerce at the Leavey School of Business
- Achieving the minimum number of quarter units specified by the major department for the bachelor of science in the School of Engineering
- Finishing a minimum of 60 quarter units of upper-division courses

- Achieving a minimum grade point average of 2.0 for all courses completed at Santa Clara University and for all courses in the academic major & any academic minor
- Meeting the residency requirement of a minimum of 45 units at the Santa Clara campus after achieving junior standing
- Fulfilling the Core Curriculum requirements in effect at the time of initial enrollment
- Attaining the requirements for any declared academic majors and minors, including for any associated college or academies.
- Submitting a completed Candidacy Petition for the bachelor's degree form according to the deadlines and procedures published by the Office of the Registrar


Student Life
