



Beaver Brook Boardwalk

1.1 miles

270 vertical feet

0.5 hours

Trail signpost with
information on all 4 sides



The Boardwalk into Beaver Brook Marsh

Parking (2-3 cars) for the boardwalk (41.939968, -72.992713) is next to the junction of King Road and Greenwood's Road. (Greenwood's Road is closed during the snow season)

Begin the hike heading southeast on Greenwood's Road. In 100 yards turn left at the sign for the Charles Pack Trail marked by a blue blaze with a yellow dot (B/Y). At 0.2 miles turn left at the junction with the Agnes Bowen Trail which is marked by a blue blaze with an orange dot (B/O). At 0.6 miles turn right 90° at the signpost (above photo) to follow the B/O trail a short distance to another signpost for the Boardwalk. Make another right 90° turn for the short walk to the wildlife viewing area at the end of the Boardwalk. To return to your car, retrace your steps back to the Trail signpost and continue straight to the gate next to Greenwood's Road. Turn left and follow this road back to your car.

Mileage summary

Hike southeast on Greenwood's Road

Turn left to follow the B/Y trail

At 0.2 turn left onto the B/O trail

At 0.6 turn right, followed by another right
to the Boardwalk

Return to your car by going straight past the
signpost and turning left onto the road.
