



2017 Stonehorse Touriga

The Stonehorse wines are full of character like the teams of Clydesdale horses that used to work the heavy clay soil at the Kaesler vineyard, long before tractors were invented. An assemblage of estate vineyards ranging in age from 15 to 45 years in age.

Winemaking

Fruit was hand-picked, put to open fermenters and hand plunged four times per day for 7 days. After malolactic fermentation, matured was in 2 and 3 year old French barriques. No fining or filtration.



Technical

Varietal(s): 100% Touriga Vintage: 2017 Vineyard: Barossa Valley and Clare Valley Vines: 7 year old vineyards Soils: Barossa is Clay loam over clay. Clare is decomposed shale of slate Gl: Barossa Valley pH: 3.9 RS: 0.5 TA: 5.3 ABV: 14%

Tasting notes

Colour: Magenta

Nose: Fresh earthy creek water overlaid with boysonberry/mulberry/blueberry. Studded through with cloves and cinnamon stick

Palate: More savoury than the nose would suggest. Upright tannins push there way around the palate, displacing fruit characters coming over from the nose. Taught acid and licorice tie it all together on the finish
