COLOUR

This Shiraz exhibits bright, lively medium reds with distinct purple hues.

BOUQUET

Fresh red berries with hints of spice, mocha, and classic chocolate and pepper notes. It has a characteristic varietal freshness.

PALATE

Fresh strawberry, raspberry, and mulberry flavours at the forefront, complemented by smooth tannins and a hint of spice.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS + WINEMAKER NOTES

Machine picked in the early morning, the fruit was then de-stemmed and immediately began the fermentation process. After 7 days on skins, the wine was pressed to tank. Once the wine had spent a few days settling in tank, it was then racked to older French oak barriques for malolactic fermentation and 15 months maturation.2021 is widely regarded as one of the greatest vintages in modern times for South Australia and the Clare Valley. The 2021 Stonehorse Shiraz epitomises all things great about the variety and the region, powerful fruit with supple tannins and a long, pure-fruited finish.
