

Los Poblanos Fields & Open Space Farm Trails is one of the largest remaining pieces of untouched agricultural land in Albuquerque.






Thousands of Sandhill Cranes have flown a long way to get here, some traveling from as far north as Canada, making New Mexico-specifically the middle of the MetroABQ--their winter vacation destination. Alfalfa is the main crop here, but the farmer, as part of his agreement with the City of ABQ, also plants wildlife crops such as sorghum, milo and millet, then corn for the fall Maize, to enhance forage for cranes and other wildlife to live on during the winter months.




Rio Grande bike paths and hiking trails. The seven-acre Maize-Maze is created each year in September and




