

Fun Games For Your Group Via Video

- JackBox—play games via a smart TV, X-box, PC, PS4, Nintendo & more. You can find more info at www.Jackboxgames.com, as well as a tutorial [here](#).
*You will need to go into your settings to make it family-friendly. 😊
- Scattergories—either with the actual cards or the [Scattergories](#) app.
- Would You Rather? There are numerous websites to find questions. [Here](#) is one I recommend.
- Two Lies and A Truth: Ask everyone to share three interesting things about themselves. (I collect model trains, I have been to Italy, I enjoy stand-up comedy). Two must be lies, and one must be true. Everyone else in the group will vote on which interesting thing is the truth. The person that tricks the most people (receives the most incorrect votes) wins the game.
- UNO—either with actual cards or the UNO app.
- Trivial Pursuit or Trivia, you can use a generator such as [this](#) and start asking questions.
- Bingo: You can go to <https://myfreebingocards.com/virtual-bingo>.
- Pictionary: You can use a [Pictionary word generator](#) and choose a team to play first. The drawer generates a word and has one minute to draw that word for their team to guess. If the team guesses the card correctly, they get the point.
- Charades: You can find an idea generator [here](#).
- Name, Place, Animal, Thing: Pick a letter. Each player has to list a famous person's name, a place, an animal, and a thing that begins with that letter--the first person to type them into the Zoom chat wins.
- Heads Up: This is a word game where the players have to describe the word on the screen to the person holding the screen to their head. You can find the app [here](#).
