Guardianship


Educating your child abroad gives them access to some of the world's most prestigious educational institutions. It is also a serious responsibility. Scion Mastery understands its crucial role in safeguarding the wellbeing of our students. It is vital that parents feel comfortable in their decision and confident that their children will receive the support they require while at school.

It is a legal requirement that any overseas pupil studying in the United Kingdom has a guardian registered in the country. Scion Mastery assumes this role but expands it in order to ensure all of your child's needs are taken care of throughout term time and during school holidays.

Scion Mastery guardianship services cover assistance with school and college applications, transfer to and from airports, regular correspondence with school, parents and students, 24-hour emergency telephone assistance, and visits from our qualified academic coaches.

As your child's education proceeds, Scion Mastery can offer a variety of additional services, from confidence and performance coaching to assistance with personal statements and job applications, life coaching and motivational training, and preparation for entry into university.

Selective School Placement

The majority of fee-paying independent schools and non fee-paying grammar schools in Britain have a competitive admissions process. In secondary education, this process commonly has three stages known as 11+ (Year 7), 13+ (Year 9) and 16+ (Sixth Form) Entry. Applications for places should be made one to three years prior to entry, with tests run a year before. However, as a general rule, it is recommended to apply as early as possible, and each school will have their own enrolment system meaning dates may vary. For instance, Eton College requires children to be registered before they are 10 years and 6 months old.

H+

For candidates wishing to enter the first year of secondary education (Year 7) applications should be made a year prior to entry (Year 6). Enrolment examinations (January, Year 6) will be required in Maths, English and Verbal Reasoning.

13+

GCSE courses are high pressure and academically rigorous, and grades achieved remain a life-long indicator of your child's ability and performance in their chosen subjects. Therefore, it is best for them to enter school in Year 9, so they can fully adjust to their new environment, choose their subjects and prepare for exams at the end of Year 11. Applications for Year 9 Entry are made in the beginning of Year 8.

16+


For students hoping to join a school to sit A-Level exams, entry to Sixth Form (Year 12) will depend heavily on GCSE results. If they are an international student, the respective equivalent to GCSEs will be required. Applications to Sixth Form are made at the beginning of Year 11.

While it is possible to enter schools at any time, Scion Mastery would advocate joining at the stages indicated. This allows your child time to acclimatise to their new environment, hone their language skills, if required, and adjust to the GCSE or A-Level course. There is some flexibility in the admission process for international students. For instance, starting Year 9 at age 14, would allow more time to learn the language before beginning the GCSE course.

Scion Mastery can advise on every step of an admissions process that can initially appear daunting. After passing our academic assessment and interview with our advisors while in your home country Scion Mastery will offer you five to ten schools that we feel will suit your ambitions and abilities. We suggest choosing three or four schools from this list and can advise on your choices. We will work with those schools and determine the chances of your child being offered a place. We will organise school visits, entry tests and interviews.

Once you have selected the school that best suits your child, Scion Mastery can help prepare for entrance exams and interviews. These usually occur from November to January before Year 9 and cover verbal and non-verbal reasoning, maths and English, followed by interviews for those applicants who pass. Many establishments, such as Eton College and Westminster School, also use their own individually designed aptitude tests. For A-Level and International Baccalaureate (IB) entry subject-specific entry tests may be set in order to evaluate the ability of a student to cope with the rigour of an A-Level programme. Depending on the test results and student's career choices, schools may advise on changing areas of study.







ISEB Test Centre:

The Independent Schools Examination Board is responsible for producing the common entrance exam for admittance to independent schools in the United Kingdom.

The exams are set by highly qualified and experienced teachers from the leading schools in the country, and viewed as the standard for assessment at II+ and I3+.

Scion Mastery is an approved test centre for ISEB examinations, allowing students from all over the world to sit pre-common entrance and common entrance tests in a secure environment in central London.



Personal Statement

Beside grades, the personal statement is the most important point of reference for schools and university admissions departments. This short piece of writing should embrace not only your reason for wanting to study a particular course, but also relevant skills and experience gained either at school or through extracurricular activities. The information from a personal statement can go on to be used as the basis for your CV or application letters in your subsequent professional career.

Scion Mastery has created a bespoke personal statement writing technique deploying life scripts to help students to create their own personal academic story.

Critically review your personal statement through discussions with our teaching staff and your peers. Write your statement highlighting your individual qualities, effectively express your interest in your area of study, and learn to avoid common mistakes made in personal statements.

Interviews preparation

Interviews can be an integral part of the admissions process at both schools and universities. This means that interviews can first take place at age seven and occur throughout your academic life and into your professional career, making it crucial to be comfortable with that environment.

Interview formats can differ between schools and universities, but in both cases those who conduct interviews often also teach the courses, so making a good impression is vital. School interviews are usually conducted by the head of house, while a university interview is undertaken by either the head of faculty or by the subject tutors at a student's chosen institution.

While entry to Oxford and Cambridge always requires an interview, an increasing number of other institutions are now using this practice to assess the suitability of students.

Interviews can be structured around a range of exercises and questions to test a student's ability, instinctive thinking and personality. Students may be asked to analyse an unseen text or piece of data. They may also be asked to answer detailed questions about their personal statement.



Whether you are an introvert or extrovert, we can help develop your confidence and improve your skills at interview. We organise mock interviews run by our tutors, all of whom attended the UK's best universities including Oxford, Cambridge, UCL and Imperial College.
