About the Course The course comprises of;

- 7 hours of intensive ground school.
- 6 hours of flight training in the Beechcraft BE76 Duchess light twin aircraft.

The intensive ground school is mainly focused on Aircraft Systems, Asymmetric Flight Characteristics and Emergency Training. There is a written theory paper and a flight test to be successfully completed. I



The aim of the Multi Engine Class Rating is to provide the Pilot with the skills and understanding necessary to safely fly a multi engine aircraft.



To begin this course you must hold an EASA PPL and have a minimum of 70 hours Pilot in Command.



Multi Engine Class Rating



Each Student commences and progresses through the course at a time and pace that suits them.



There is no set period during which the training must be completed. Our standard operating procedures dictate a maximum of 4 hours flying/simulator training per day and 20 hours in any 6 day period.



National Flight Centre Pilot Academy operate a pay as you go policy i.e. you pay for each training session after you receive it.

Additional charges will be made by the Irish Aviation Authority for the issue of the ME Class Rating. There is a charge to be paid by the student to the IAA Examiner that conducts the Pilot skills test.
