Instructions and Sample: Figures Page

If you include figures, list them on a Figures Page in the front of your thesis. The Figures Page should be the page immediately following the Contents Page. (Since the Contents Page only lists material which follows it, your Figures Page, if you include one, will be the first item listed on your Contents Page.) Be sure to consult Turabian, 9th ed., 393, and Fig. A.5. If you have questions about this element of your thesis, please email ctw@wts.edu. See the sample Figures Page below.

Type the word “Figures” centered at the top of the page. If the list is more than one page, do not repeat the title.

FIGURES

Leave two blank lines between the title and the first item listed.

Leave a 1-1/2" left margin.

1. Christian essentialism: The creator/creature distinction 15
2. John Frame’s square of opposition 26
3. Nature-grace dualism, natural law, and natural theology 57
4. Poythress’ triad of meaning 92

Consecutively number each figure using Arabic numerals.

Leader dots may be used, but they are not required.

Leave a blank line between entries. You may single space within a single entry.

The numbering, wording, and capitalization of the captions should exactly match that used in the figure captions in the body of the thesis. Figure captions should be formatted using sentence-style capitalization.

Use Roman Numerals to number the pages in the front matter.
