Instructions and Sample: The Abbreviations Page

According to the seminary's Format Guidelines, if you use abbreviations in the body of your text, footnotes, or bibliography, you must include a list of the abbreviations with their matching full titles on an Abbreviations Page. Follow the instructions for formatting the Abbreviations Page found in Turabian, 9th ed., 398, and Fig. A.7, but use the abbreviations, italicization, and punctuation as shown in the list of secondary sources in chapter 8 of The SBL Handbook, 2nd ed.
