The final training segment included a group activity to encourage teamwork and creativity among the staff where they got together to work in groups to create a photo board for the various centres.

The journey was smooth and soon we reached Amari Hotel that is just a short distance from JB City Square. We checked in, rested and had dinner together. GREETINGS FROM CHAIRMAN & EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Building Our Children's Identity

I was reading the devotional notes this week written by a very dear friend of mine, Dr Selwyn Hughes who was an internationally acclaimed speaker and author. He said that the things we think we see in the eyes of those who nurture us become the building blocks on which we construct our identity.

If I see and sense that I belong to a loving family, then building block number one is placed beneath my feet. If I see I am valued for who I am and not what I can do, then building block number two goes into place. If I see that those who nurture me consider I have a significant role to play in the world, then building block number three is added. As far as our natural identity is concerned, we are the products of those who either loved us, or failed to love us, in a way which would have helped to put in place these building blocks. Those who regrettably do not have these three building blocks put in place rarely know who they are, and go through life with an incomplete sense of identity ¹.

Begin with building block number one, a loving family. Each in the family may respond to love in different ways. Gary Chapman in his book *The Five Love Languages*, recommends 5 ways to express and experience love: receiving gifts, quality time, words of affirmation, acts of service and physical touch ². Try practicing these 5 love languages in your family.

Value one another in the family for who we are, not what we do. You love your spouse for who he is or who she is and not how well they perform in their career. Likewise you love your children for who they are, your sons and daughters, which is not dependent on how well they perform to meet your expectations. Never compare them with others.

Encourage one another in the family. Everyone has the ability to play a significant role in the world around him or her. See beyond the physical and identify their hidden gifts, abilities and talents. Create opportunities for them to use them and affirm them.

Parents, always keep in mind that children learn by modeling. Let's help them develop their sense of identity by building these building blocks in them.


从第一块积木开始,一个充满爱的家庭。家庭中的每个人都可能以不同的方式回应爱。Gary Chapman在他的书 - The Five Love Languages 中建议5种方式来表达和体验爱:接受礼物,质量时间,肯定的话语,服务和肢体行为。尝试在家中练习这5种爱的语言。

在家庭中,我们应该珍惜彼此,而不在于我们所做的事情上。你爱你的配偶是因为他或她是你所爱的对象,而不是他们在职业生涯中的表现如何。同样,你爱你的孩子是因为他们是你的儿子和女儿,他们不依赖于他们表现如何,以达到你的期望。永远不要与他人做比较。

在家庭中互相鼓励。每个人都有能力在他或她周围的世界中发挥重要作用。找出他们隐藏的潜能,能力和才能。为他们创造机会,让他们使用并确认他们。

父母总要记住, 孩子们通过长者的榜样来学习。让我们通过在他们身上建立这些积木, 来帮助他们发展自己的认同感。

Thus, I look forward to many more great years of working with my wonderful team of co-workers to serve and help the community we are in.


To God be the Glory!


SENTOSA OUTING

此次活动能让幼儿在安全、舒适和干净的环境下尽情的享受四处走动的乐趣,是一个深受幼儿喜爱的体育活动。
