BREAKFAST CLUB

Students should be dropped off at the Gables building (front door).

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

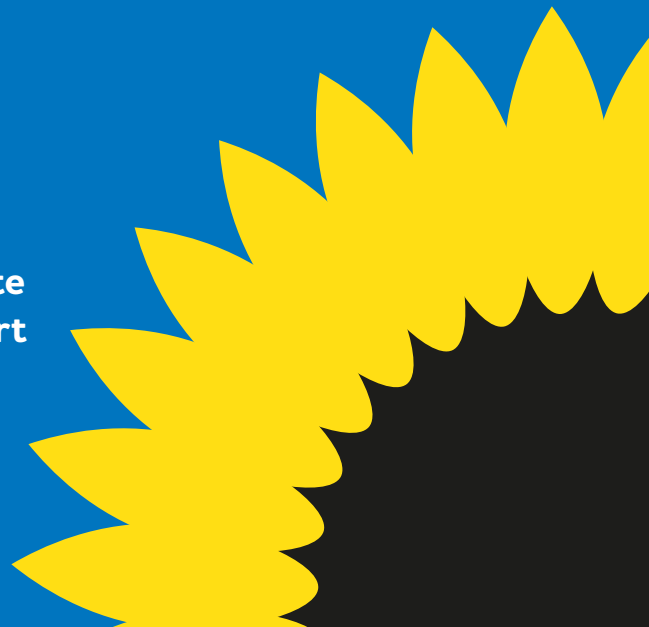


After school club

TEAM

Our team at St Helen's consists of a blend of St Helen's School staff and Camp Beaumont camp team members. Led by our interim manager, Mickey Peters, provision will be overseen by a range of experienced staff members ready to ensure children have a great time while with us.

Staff Ratios:

3-7 years old: 1 member of staff to every 8 children (1:8)

8+ years old: 1 member of staff to every 12 children (1:12)

Camp Beaumont operate a very strict recruitment process ensuring all necessary checks are completed to ensure all employees are suitable to work with children.

All team members are fully referenced and undergo an Enhanced Disclosure Baring Service (DBS) check.

Throughout employment all staff and management are subject to regular observations to monitor performance and extra training where required to ensure staff are maintaining outstanding levels of safeguarding processes.

All staff complete a blend of face-to-face and e-learning training which includes paediatric first aid, food safety and safeguarding. All supervisors and managers will be trained Designated Safeguarding Officers (DSO)
