The Framework forms the foundation to ensure that children in all early childhood education and care settings experience quality teaching and learning. It emphasises play-based learning and recognises the importance of communication, language, social and emotional development.

What is Family Day Care?

Family Day Care is childcare provided in the educator's home. Wanslea Family Day Care emphasises relationships in small groups and a warm, nurturing, home-like environment, and is available for children up to 12 years. The educator can care for children of different ages, so brothers and sisters can remain close.

Who looks after my child?

Educators are child-focused, with childcare training and qualifications. They enjoy engaging with children to build trust and provide experiences that support each individual child's strengths and interests.

What happens during the day?

Routines are flexible and often change according to the children's needs and interests. The educator is sensitive to the way your child settles in, and the home is set up daily with small group activities. If you have time, you are welcome to join in before you leave for the day.



Can I claim the Child Care Subsidy?

The Child Care Subsidy helps with the cost of approved child care for eligible families. The Australian Government pays it directly to your child care provider to reduce your fees.
