The Brent Equity & Inclusion Group advances Brent's commitment to cultivating an equitable and inclusive community where everyone feels a strong sense of belonging. We center race, equity, social justice, class, gender, disability, and inclusionall in collaboration with the Brent faculty and administration, the Brent PTA and LSAT, and our partners at Kindred, a nonprofit organization that supports communities in creating antiracist and liberated schools.

Through authentic relationships, community-led change, and continual growth, we work to remove barriers to opportunities and resources based on identity. We support holistic growth and well-being for students, as well as caregivers and staff members.

Who we are

We are an open group of caregivers, teachers, staff, and school leaders of all races, identities, and backgrounds. This includes caregivers who built knowledge and connections in school year 2022-2023 as part of a Kindred-facilitated racial justice dialogue group.

Activities

We are planning a mix of dialogue, outreach, and communityled change, including:

- Building on lessons learned from the school year 2022-2023 caregiver dialogue groups and continuing the work with the wider school community. This will include: ongoing identity processing, ongoing community building, deepening our understanding of the history of schooling as it relates to oppression and inequity, and exploring what it all means for our Brent community.
- Regular focus groups and listening sessions to build connection and understanding of what inclusion and belonging can look like at the school.

Activities will include a mix of in-person and online to ensure accessibility.
