**AMERICAN CRYPTOFED DAO LLC'S**  
**MOTION TO CORRECT MATERIAL**  
**ERRORS IN THE HEARING TRANSCRIPT.**

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC” or “Commission”) instituted this proceeding by an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on November 18, 2022. The OIP ordered American CryptoFed DAO LLC (“American CryptoFed” or “Respondent”) to file an Answer within ten days after service of the OIP and ordered that a public hearing before Administrative Law Judge Carol Fox Foelak commence at 10:00 a.m. EST on December 1, 2022. Hearing sessions were held on December 1, 2, and 6, 2022, and January 18 and 19, 2023, and the hearing was closed. During the hearing, we agreed with the Division of Enforcement’s suggestion below for transcript correction.

MR. BRUCKMANN: The rules of practice normally provide that any corrections to the transcript need to be done before the first pre- hearing brief is filed. I would prefer that it be done by the time of the reply brief. It's just been my experience that when writing the briefs is when you discover potentially errors. And so, if there are minor errors, it's easiest for the parties to work together and get them done by the time of the reply brief filing. Some might be discovered before then, **but I just, I'd hate to lose the opportunity for either side to fix an error.** (January 19, 2023 Transcript, P. 715:15-26, 716:1-2, emphasis added).

On April 17, 2023, the Division suggested that American CryptoFed include the following statement in this motion seeking for correction:

“The Division of Enforcement was given an opportunity to review these corrections and defers to the Administrative Law Judge regarding whether these corrections are necessary.”

Accordingly, the material errors for correction in the record are attached as Exhibit A.

For all the reasons set forth above, American CryptoFed respectfully petitions that Judge Foelak approve the transcript corrections as documented in Exhibit A.
