Advocacy

PPCC's Firefly Chat is a free series of interactive virtual conversations where caregivers and medical professionals discuss the challenges they face and share resources for managing those challenges. PPCC also provides seminars and participates in affiliated events in communities throughout the state, offering opportunities for learning, networking and collaboration.

The Lightning Bug App

This free app helps parents and caregivers easily record, organize and retrieve their child's medical data, all in one central location. It also offers tools to help coordinate care, communicate with multiple providers and ensure their child's data remains accurate and up-to-date.
