ART on the Rail Trail Presents Birds on the Rail Trail A New Addition to MHLC's Annual Summer Hike-a-thon Scavenger Hunt July 1 - 31, 2022

Delmar, NY—Art on the Rail Trail (ART) is hosting its first scavenger hunt along the Helderberg-Hudson Rail Trail. This event coincides with Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy's Summer Hike-a-thon Scavenger Hunt, which is occurring at all its preserves. These on-your-own events will be happening for the entire month of July.

Twelve artists have contributed at least 18 original bird-themed sculptures that will be installed along the 9-mile Albany County Helderberg-Hudson Rail Trail for visitors to find. Located in plain sight, on trees and fencing, these whimsical creatures and their habitats will be accompanied by QR codes that offer directions on how to participate in the 'hunt.'

The birds hidden on the trails of MHLC's preserves are wood cutouts that have been hand-painted by MHLC volunteers. There is one bird at each of MHLC's 22 preserves. Participants can register for free via the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy's website to receive a list of clues.

Registered participants who submit a photo of at least one of the pieces, will win a gift card for a free ice cream scoop from event sponsor Stewart's Shops as well as an entry into a drawing to win one of the pieces that are being donated by the artists and a birdhouse from Wildbird Junction in Delmar.

To celebrate the month-long scavenger hunt, ART will host two **Woodcut Painting Workshops on Saturday July 9, 2022, at 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. at the Albany County Rail Trail Pavilion in Voorheesville.**Community members can join Art on the Rail Trail for a special Woodcut Painting Workshop with local artists Grace Lang and Ramiro Davaro-Comas. Workshop participants will paint a bird-themed woodcut figure to bring home! The event is free and open to children of all ages, and all supplies are provided. Advance registration is required.
