- Utah is proud to be home to companies like **Adobe, Ancestry, Domo, Texas Instruments, Qualtrics**, and many others. Utah is one of the top states in the nation for information technology employment, with an impressive employee base of more than 86,000.
- Just three of Utah's efforts to align education and industry are the **Silicon Slopes Industry Association, Women Tech Council**, and **Tech Moms**, a non-profit that assists women as they transition their careers into technical roles.
- **Utah's tech sector has been referred to as the next "Silicon Valley"**, and is one of the fastest-growing states for tech jobs in the nation with an increase of 6.5% in 2022.

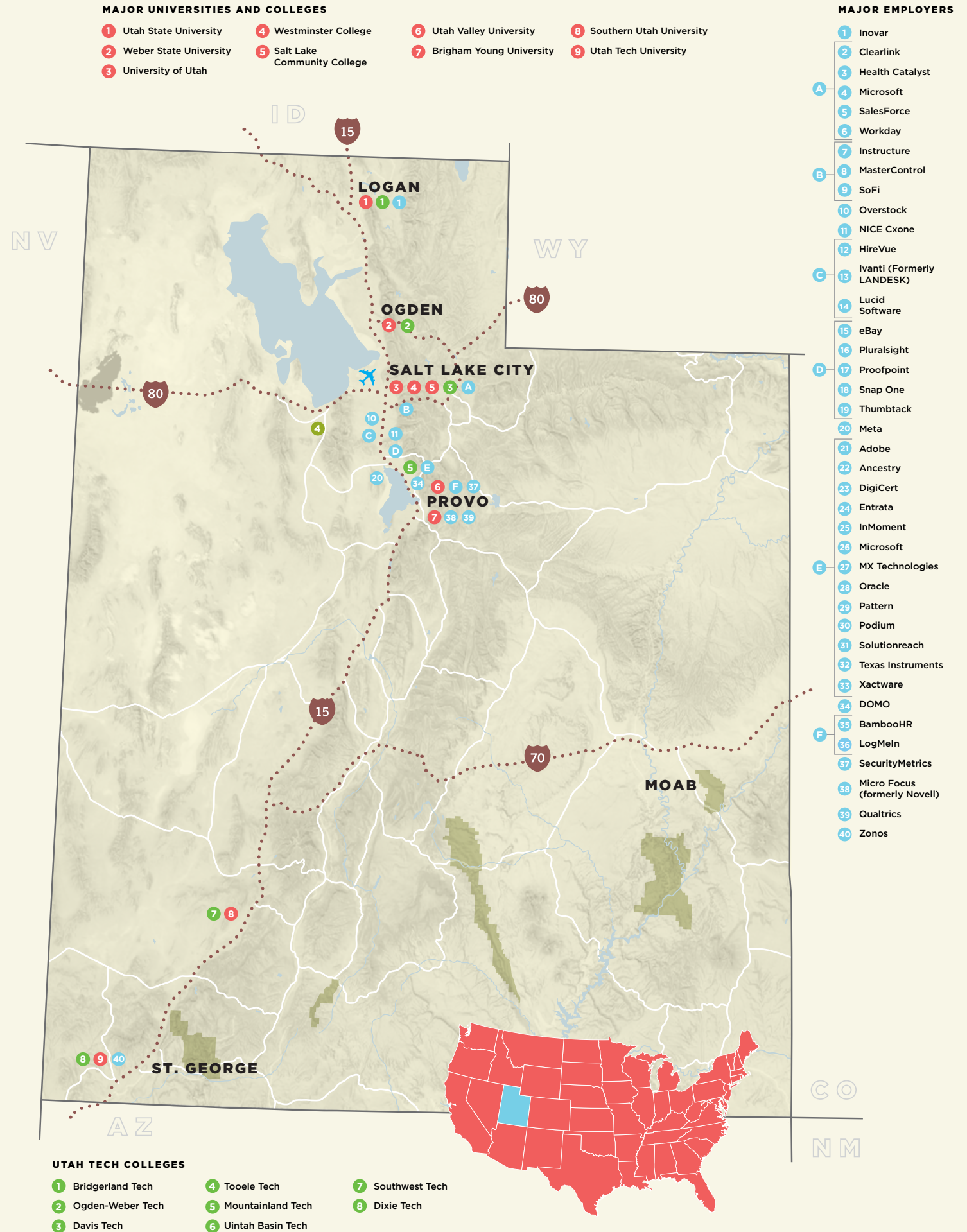
- US News ranked Utah the **#1 Best State Overall in 2023**. Utah also ranked 1st in Economy and Fiscal Stability.

Adobe Lehi Campus

Software giant Adobe will substantially expand its Utah presence, announcing plans to build a new \$90 million facility in addition to the \$74 million facility already completed in Lehi, UT.

- In 2022, Utah's post-performance tax incentives program facilitated over **20,400 new jobs and more than \$942M in new state revenues**.
 - In 2023, the Tax Foundation ranked Utah's "Total Tax Climate" as the **8th best in the nation**. Since 2011, Utah has eliminated or modified over 400 business regulations to ease the burdens placed on businesses.

- Utah has **high employee concentrations of Software Developers, Web Developers, Computer and Information Research Scientists**, and many other IT related occupations.
 - With **11 major institutions offering programs related to Software and IT**, Utah has a wealth of Software and Information Technology education resources.
 - Utah has over 10,100 IT related establishments that call Utah home. In particular, Utah has an **abundance of Software Publishing companies**, with more than 18,000 people employed in the industry and growing rapidly.

LiveView Technologies Expanding in Utah (2022)

LiveView Technologies will expand its Orem, UT headquarters, bringing up to 3,400 new high-paying jobs and over \$328 million in capital investment over the next 10 years. LiveView Technologies provides a cloud-based software platform and rugged hardware that collects, stores, and organizes data from various sensors via cellular networks.

Tech Company Scorpion to Open an Office in Utah (2021)

Scorpion announced plans to open an office in Utah, adding up to 1,007 new high-paying jobs and \$18.9 million in capital investment in the state over the next five years. Scorpion is a digital marketing and technology company that provides business growth services, technology solutions, and software applications to small and medium-sized businesses across the country to help companies attract more customers, improve operational efficiency, and increase revenue.

Brandless is Expanding in Utah (2021)

Brandless, Inc. will expand in Lindon, Utah, bringing up to 1,033 new high-paying jobs in the next 10 years. Brandless is one of the world's fastest-growing omnichannel commerce platforms for consumer products. Brandless is also a platform for other mission-driven, digitally-native brands to accelerate growth and become a force for good with the core belief that making better choices should be simple and easy.

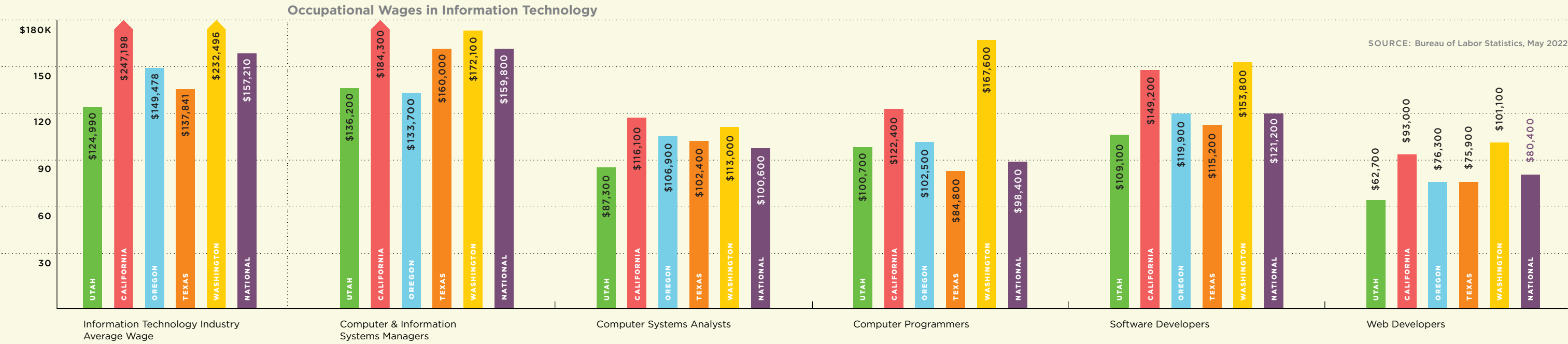
Meta (Formerly Facebook) Expands Utah Data Center Campus by 900,000 SF (2021)

Meta announced plans to expand its Eagle Mountain data center campus by more than 900,000 square feet with two new buildings. Once completed, this data center will represent an investment of more than \$1 billion. The Eagle Mountain Data Center will be supported by 100% renewable energy from solar projects funded by Facebook, including more than 600 MW of new solar energy to the Utah grid. In addition, the company has invested in a project that will restore water to the Provo River.

Domo to Expand its Utah Office (2021)

Domo announced plans to expand its Utah location, adding up to 2,230 new high-paying jobs and \$30 million in capital investment in the state over the next 10 years. Domo is a cloud-based software company that helps customers transform the way business is managed and drive more value from their business data by making it accessible and actionable for everyone, from the CEO to the front-line worker. The company, with revenue growth of more than 20% per year, was founded in Utah County in 2010 and went public in 2018.

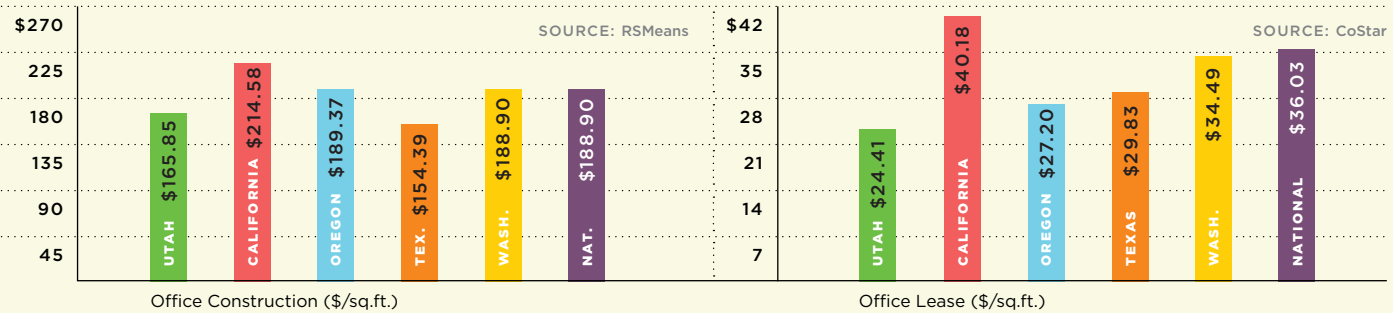
Cost Profile



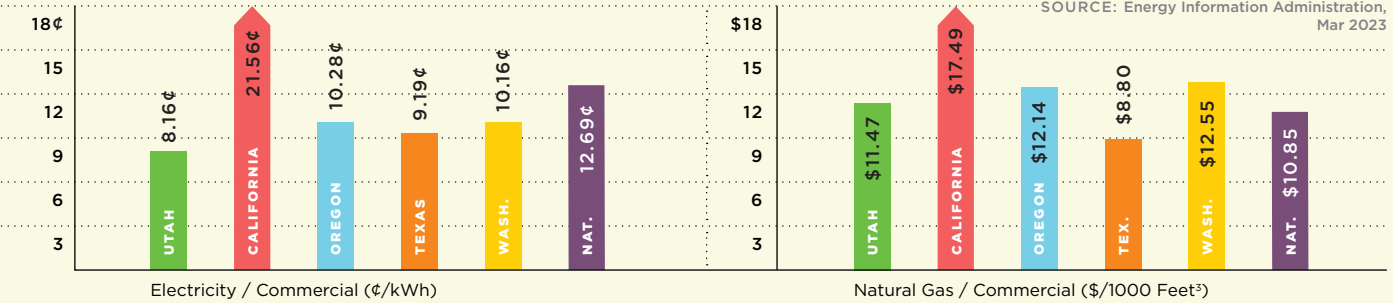

A State of Education

Utah is home to **12 major colleges and universities** and has an excellent talent pipeline of over **269,000** students. Bachelor’s and graduate awards grew by **16.7% over the last five years**. Utah has an educated workforce, with over 93% of the population 25 or over with a high school diploma and over **36.8%** with a bachelor’s degree.

DEGREE: Information Technology Pathways

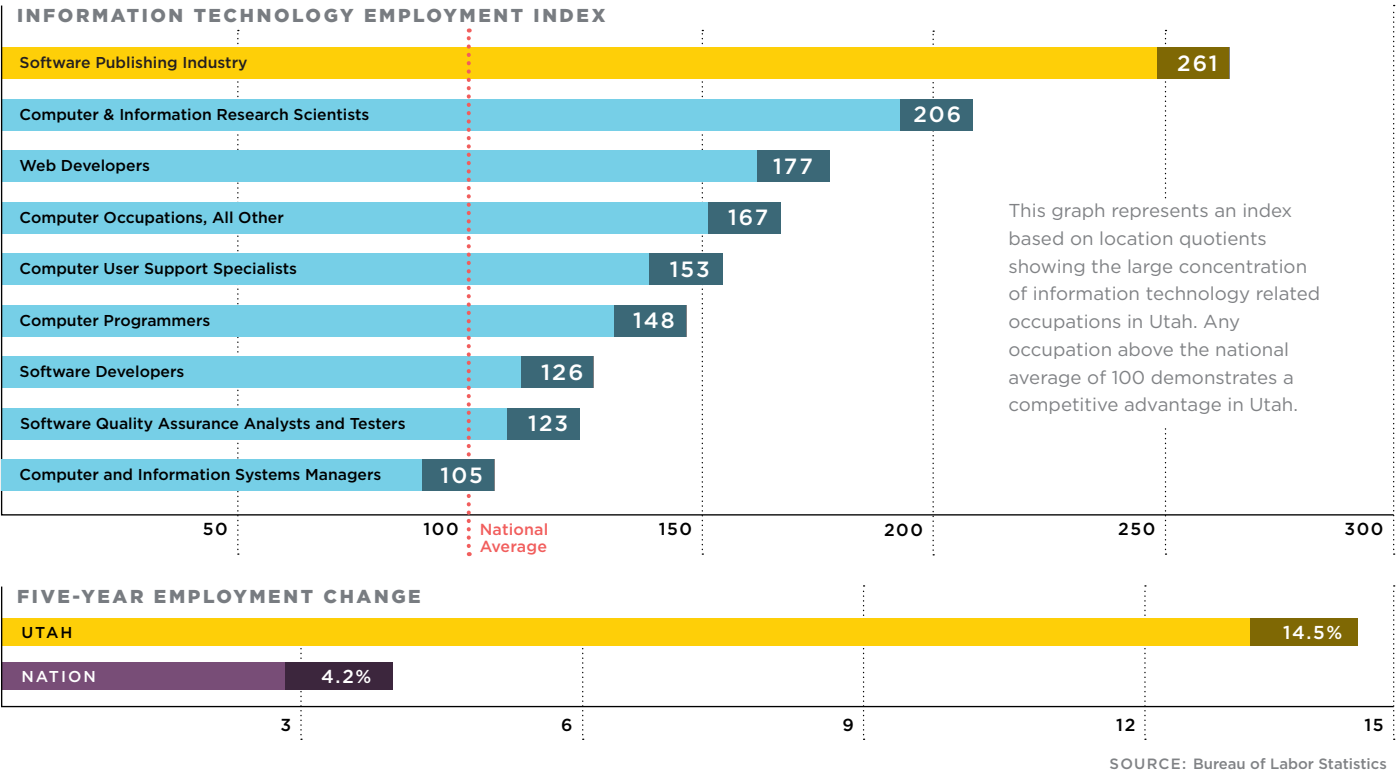


University of Utah

The Labor Picture

Utah’s labor force is well educated, growing, and affordable. Utah **created over 60,000 jobs in 2022** and maintained one of the highest job growth rates in the nation throughout the year. Utah is the youngest state in the nation with a median age of 31.8 and has an average wage of \$57,360, which is **7% lower than the national average**.
