PYRIDOXINE

Pyridoxine:

Dosing in concert with isoniazid

For children >50kg and adults, when isoniazid is given intermittently, give pyridoxine for daily self-administration)

Age group	Dose (mg po)
Children <12 kg	6.25 mg every other day
Children <12-25 kg	12.5 mg every other day
Children 25-50 kg	25 mg every other day
Children >50 kg and adults	50 mg daily

Pyridoxine:

Dosing in concert with twice weekly isoniazid for

- children <50kg, or
- adults and children >50kg who cannot be relied upon to take the pyridoxine daily by self-administration:

Age group	Dose (mg po with each dose of isoniazid)
Children <25 kg	12.5 mg
Children 25-50 kg	25 mg
Children >50 kg and adults	50 mg
