

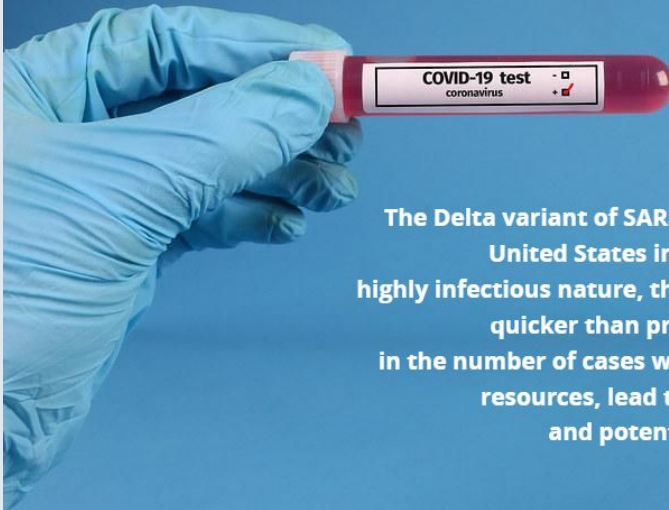

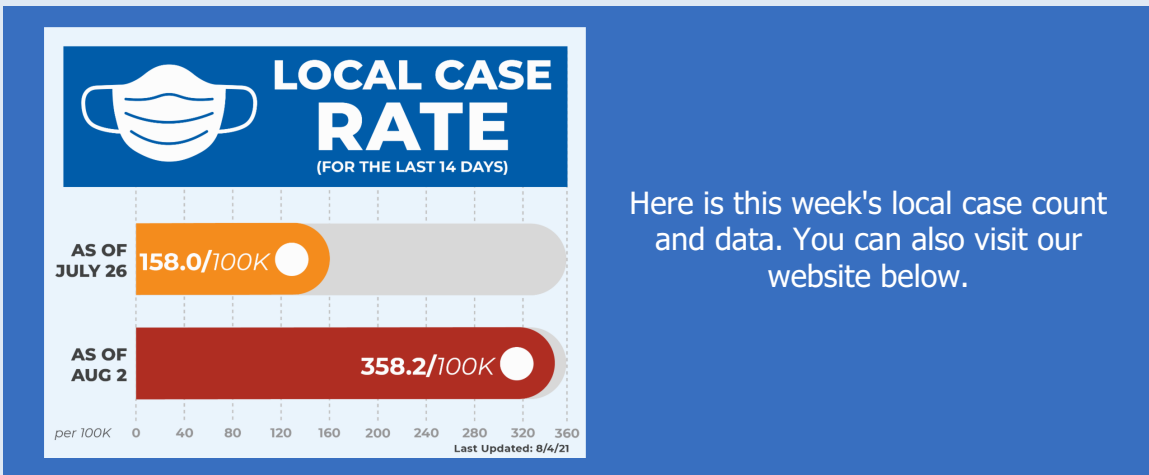
DELTA Variant



The Delta variant of SARS-CoV-2 was first detected in the United States in March 2021. Due to its highly infectious nature, the Delta variant spreads faster and quicker than prior strains. An increase in the number of cases will put more strain on healthcare resources, lead to more hospitalizations and potentially more deaths

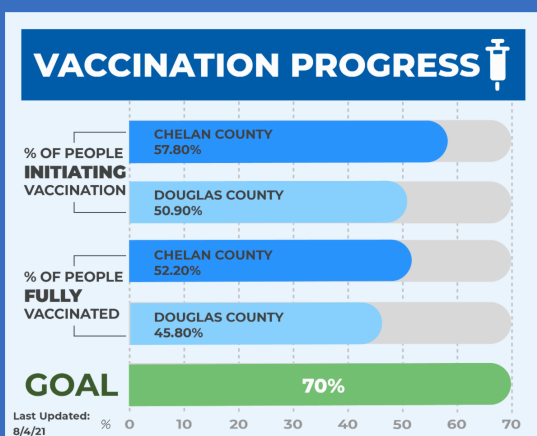
