BUILD A TEAM

Lk. 9; 10; 1 Thess. 2; Acts 2 – notice the “we’s”

VALUE: Why build a team?

1. Team is more effective in general than one person – good team work makes for winning teams
2. Teamwork is more freeing: One person is not responsible for everything, not have to do everything, not have to be expert
3. Teamwork is more visible example of deep relationships, of unity of believers, a model in miniature of the body of Christ in action
4. Teamwork is more fun than doing something alone: sharing load, sharing the burden of the task, sharing the planning, sharing the results
5. Teamwork affirms the giftedness of each person: each person has something to bring to the team in order for the team to be successful
6. Teamwork uses the giftedness of each member.
7. Teamwork helps people to grow into better leaders, helping people who are young in their faith and/or leadership to be successful as a member of a team can lead to their being a team leader in another setting at a later date. E.g., Hyackers going to college and leading high school groups in their churches at their college/university cities.
8. Teamwork means giving my life away to others, helping all of us to succeed.
9. Teamwork builds people into the local Body of Christ.

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
