BUILD A TEAM

Lk. 9; 10; 1 Thess. 2; Acts 2 – notice the "we's"

VALUE: Why build a team?

- 1. Team is more effective in general than one person good team work makes for winning teams
- 2. Teamwork is more freeing: One person is not responsible for everything, not have to do everything, not have to be expert
- 3. Teamwork is more visible example of deep relationships, of unity of believers, a model in miniature of the body of Christ in action
- 4. Teamwork is more fun than doing something alone: sharing load, sharing the burden of the task, sharing the planning, sharing the results
- 5. Teamwork affirms the giftedness of each person: each person has something to bring to the team in order for the team to be successful
- 6. Teamwork uses the giftedness of each member.
- 7. Teamwork helps people to grow into better leaders, helping people who are young in their faith and/or leadership to be successful as a member of a team can lead to their being a team leader in another setting at a later date. E.g., Hyackers going to college and leading high school groups in their churches at their college/universt iy cities.
- 8. Teamwork means giving my life away to others, helping all of us to succeed.
- 9. Teamwork builds people into the local Body of Christ.
