



MEANINGS CAPITAL PARTNERS ANNOUNCES THE LAUNCH OF A MAJOR PROGRAMME TO TRANSFORM OFFICES INTO OVER 22,000 M2 OF HOUSING AND SHOPS NEAR PARIS

Meanings Capital Partners announces the conversion of the two buildings of GEFCO's former head office in Courbevoie (Hauts-de-Seine) and the construction of two new high-environmental-quality buildings to create a residential property complex measuring over 22,000 square metres in the capital's inner suburbs. Close to La Défense, it is intended for housing in various forms (home ownership, intermediate social and rental housing as well as co-living) with an active base of shops and services on the ground floor of buildings. The "Parc des Lilas d'Espagne" Real Estate programme also covers the development of 7,650 m² of green spaces, including a 4,000 m² park that will be created and transferred to Courbevoie Town Hall, becoming an open public space.

The entire project will meet the highest environmental standards and is targeting the NF Habitat HQE, BREEAM, SmartScore Silver, Biodiversity, Eco-Jardin and RE2020 labels for the new section. Work will begin in the summer of 2024, with delivery scheduled for the second half of 2026.

The programme is ideally located in the immediate vicinity of La Défense, Europe's largest business centre, featuring a transport hub (M1, RER A, RER E, T2, Transilien L and U), businesses, shopping centres and higher education facilities. It is also surrounded by numerous green spaces such as Parc Nelson Mandela, Parc du Millénaire and Parc des Pins.

Sustainable value creation through environmental requirements

As a multi-activity management company and a leading player in responsible investment in unlisted assets, Meanings Capital Partners is committed to a sustainable value creation approach, in line with its DNA as a Humanly Responsible Investor®.



The management company is a pioneer in its requirements on the decarbonisation of its entire investment portfolio. Converting offices into housing is fully aligned with this strategy. The real estate sector is focusing its environmental efforts on new buildings – given the pace of real estate renewal, 80% of the buildings that will be in service in 2050 already exist today.

Meanings believes that transforming obsolete assets for new uses, combined with the contribution of functional diversity or adapted services, are the best drivers for creating lasting value. This choice is aligned with the decarbonisation goals of Meanings Capital Partners, in accordance with the Paris Agreements, while respecting global limits: its 10-year trajectory is validated by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi), an independent reference body and the only global scientific, objective and universal measure of the ambition and stringency of the decarbonisation strategies put in place by businesses and financial players.

Develop energy-efficient, resilient and outstanding assets

To reduce the emissions of its entire building portfolio by at least 56% per m² by 2032, Meanings Capital Partners is rallying significant resources to assist its projects in their transformation, rethink energy uses and sources of supply, and carry out quality restructuring involving extensive work at an average cost of between €800 and €1,500/m² on energy improvement alone. In September 2022, Meanings Real Estate Fund (MREF) was also one of the first Value Add funds to obtain the Real Estate Socially Responsible Investment (SRI) label.

The Value Add transformation led by Meanings aims to truly converge the "non-financial" and "financial" added values. An asset that meets its stakeholders' expectations is more resilient and effective over time. The scarcity of energy-efficient buildings makes them less expensive to use and more attractive, and they will increasingly attract a valuation premium.

"This landmark operation to convert former offices into housing comes in direct response to the challenge of the housing shortage in the Paris region. It illustrates Meanings' ambition to convert and decarbonise the assets in its portfolios with a view to creating sustainable and shared value," said Hervé Fonta, President of Meanings, and Charles de Guerry, Partner.
