1. Friends (John 15:15)

- Friends with Jesus
- Friends with one another (Hebrews 10:25)
- Greek word koinonia = fellowship

2. How Do We Tell Others?

- God as our Father (John 1:12)
- Brothers and sisters to each other (1 John 4:19 5:1)
- Importance of unity
- Jesus prayed '... that they may be one' (John 17:11)

Becoming a Christian involves:

- Something God does he gives you the Holy Spirit
- Something you do you repent and believe
- Something the church does baptism

Baptism is the visible mark of being a member of the church.

Baptism signifies:

- Cleansing from sin (1 Corinthians 6:11)
- Dying and rising with Christ (Romans 6:3–5; Colossians 2:12)

3. Home (*Ephesians 2:19 –22*)

- Old Testament physical temple was God's home
- New Testament a building made up of people (Ephesians 2:21–22)
 - Jesus as the cornerstone (v.20)
 - Indwelt by God's Spirit (v.21) 'a holy temple'
 - A place where people are loved, accepted and welcomed home

4. Jesus (1 Corinthians 12:1-27)

- We are the body of Christ through whom the world will see Jesus
 (v.27)
- Universal church (*Ephesians 3:10,21; 5:23,25*)
 - Unity (John 17:20-21)
 - Diversity (Ephesians 4:7-11)
 - Mutual dependence (vv.14–26)
