## 4. How do we pray?

- Thank you - count your blessings, not your problems
- Sorry - confess your sins (John 13:6-10)
- Please - 'Give us today our daily bread' (Matthew 6:11): ask for anything you need.


## 5. When should we pray?

- Anywhere, anytime - (Ephesians 6:18)
- Alone (Matthew 6:6)
-     - Regular pattern
-     - Best part of the day (Mark 1:35)
- With others
-     - There's power in praying together
-     - 'Where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am in their midst.' (Matthew 18:20)
