Food For Families

A nutritional food bank providing fresh fruit, vegetables, bread, dairy, and meat to vulnerable kids, families, and seniors. Each week we serve 1,000 households (3000 people) across Vancouver, Port Coquitlam, and Surrey.

Club Freedom

A program that targets those who are experiencing homelessness, poverty, addiction, or mental health issues through serving over 9000 delicious hot meals every year and offering a Christian worship service every week.

Adopt-A-School

Creating partnerships with under-resourced public schools with a high population of low-income households. We are able to offer them special access to our programs and events and resources, such as backpacks full of school supplies, haircuts, hygiene kits, Christmas gifts, and fresh food hampers. Currently we have relationship with 42 public schools.

Out of School Care

A faith-based before and after school care program for children aged 5-12 serving the local public elementary school district. We have 35 full-time students throughout the year and dozens more each year at our spring and summer camps.

CityReach Bees

Did you know that bees are disappearing at an alarming rate on a global scale? In response, the City of Vancouver has reached out and asked anyone who has the ability to keep bees to do so. As we seek to partner with our city and care for God's creation, we have decided to do our part in helping nature's little striped pollinators thrive by starting our own bee apiary on our roof with 4 hives.
