- Discussed Senate Bill 5693.
 - -Established transition coordination teams.
 - -Increasing stability and timeliness of transitions.
 - -Annual reporting.
- Discussed the stages of transition.
 - -Transition prep.
 - -Active coordination of transition (The act stage).
 - -Post move and stabilization.
- Developing standard communication.
- Statewide Assurance.
- From 2018-2022: 544 transitions, 52 returns.
- Follow up schedule and transition survey schedule.
- Transition survey used to determine how individual is adjusting after their move and to make recommendations that support successful transition.
- These surveys can reveal insight about transition progress and if goals are being supported.
 - -They can also identify potential barriers to services.
 - -Promote stability in the new home by asking DDA staff to address barriers or concerns.
 - -Provide accountability to individual and F/G/A that support is meeting their needs.
 - -And can produce data that will be analyzed to identify trends and improve transition outcomes.
- Revised survey is shorter to increase participation.
- New questions have been developed for the survey for both the individual and the F/G/A and provider.

 Requirement Plan staff to perform CARE level of Care assessments virtually and obtain electronic
 signatures on Person-Centered Service Plans.
- Add an agency provider type for the service Residential Habilitation/Alternative Living (AL) on the CORE waiver and project increased utilization of AL in waiver years 2023-2024 through 2026-2027.
