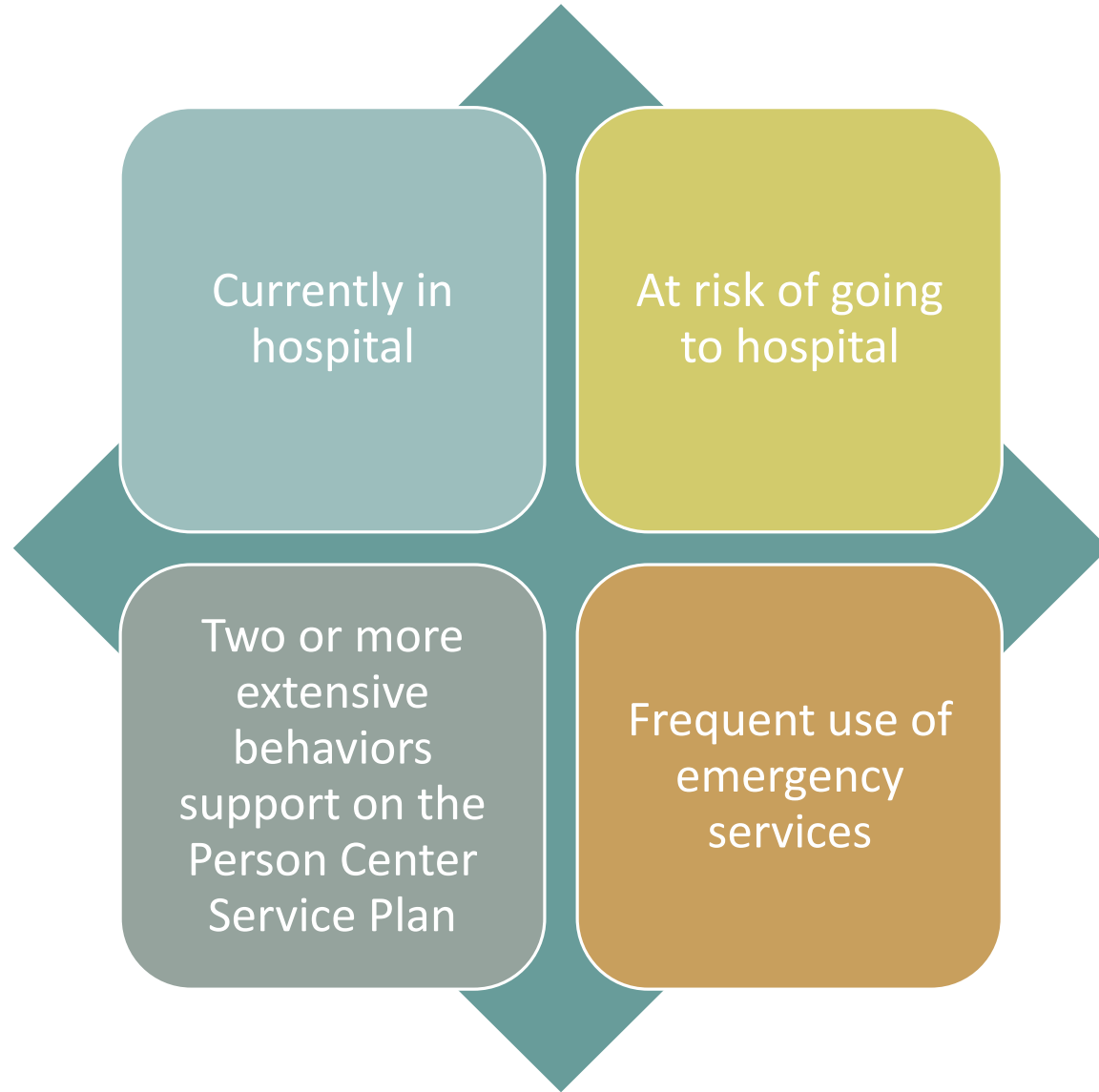

The Pilot requires provider to train Direct Support Professionals to an enhanced training curriculum that includes Dual Diagnosis training, Crisis Intervention and Prevention training, Trauma Informed training, and addition hours of client specific training.
