"God's aseity is his existence from himself; that is, he exists without influence or input or resources or forces or anything from outside himself. The biblical picture of God is that he is complete and sufficient and flawless, and without any defect or deficiency in and of himself. That means before there was any creation, and apart from any creation, and independent of any creation, God was completely and flawlessly God." Desiring God
