Revenue streams and royalties from sustainable and recurring use of land and assets, such as water, agriculture, sustainable timber and sustainable building solutions through long term financial structures, thereby identifying novel ways to monetize traditional resources.



IP & Digital Assets

Acquire the rights to intellectual property and patents, and purchase and/or fund the development of infrastructure and assets that go to serve data centers, information technologies, and digital currencies.
