DFSS Executive Updates – Presented by Cerathel Burgess Burnett, Deputy Commissioner of DFSS Children Services Division

- ACF-PI-HS-21-01 FY2021 Head Start Funding Increase
  - ➤ There is additional funding for Head Start agencies. COLA is 1.22%. Delegate agencies apply for it and go to staff at HS, EHS, EHSCCP, EHSEXP. City of Chicago will apply and work with agencies to complete the application.
  - Quality dollars are for migrant and seasonal grantees. City of Chicago is not a migrant or seasonal program.
  - ➤ DFSS anticipates receiving additional funds. DFSS has already received \$11 million. The dollars are based on the total funded enrollment. Dollars are specific and will go to Covid related activities. Examples are listed in the program instruction.
  - ➤ Waiver for non-federal match City will request a waiver and apply for funds.
