

Background Information

- √ Kajiado County covers an approximate area of 21,871 square kilometers.
- ✓ Estimated population is 1,117,840 people (KNBS 2019).
- ✓ It is administratively divided into five sub counties namely: Kajiado Central, Kajiado North, Kajiado South, Kajiado East and Kajiado West.
- ✓ There are three main livelihood zones namely; pastoral all species (52%), Agro-pastoral (31%) and mixed farming (12%) livelihood zones.
- ✓ The survey was conducted in Kajiado Central, Sajiloni location in Inkuseron and Elerai villages -Come Unity operational areas.

- ✓ The survey applied a LQAS sampling (Five Supervision areas).




Sex of respondents








Highest grade level completed





Main source of income for the household






Main source of drinking water



Percentage of households using an improved source for drinking water within acceptable reach (water that is either on the premises or within 30 minutes of household)




Household water treatment



Percentage of households using recommended household water treatment technologies (Boiling, Add bleach/chlorine/water guard or Use water filter)


Household safe water storage



Percentage of households that safely store drinking water




Coverage by an improved toilet facility




Percentage of households using an improved toilet facility

Kind of toilet facility






Cleanliness of toilet facility



Percent of household with toilet facilities that meet cleanliness criteria (Partially)


Safe disposal of feces



Percentage of households that disposed of the youngest child's feces safely the last time she or he passed stool




Dedicated handwashing station within the parameters of the home

Percentage of households with all essential handwashing supplies readily available




Household Dietary Diversity

Household Dietary Diversity (24 hr. Recall)





Percentage of households with VSL group member(s) that participate in a Come Unity supported IGA






Community and stakeholder participation

Percentage of households that participate in community/school gardens







