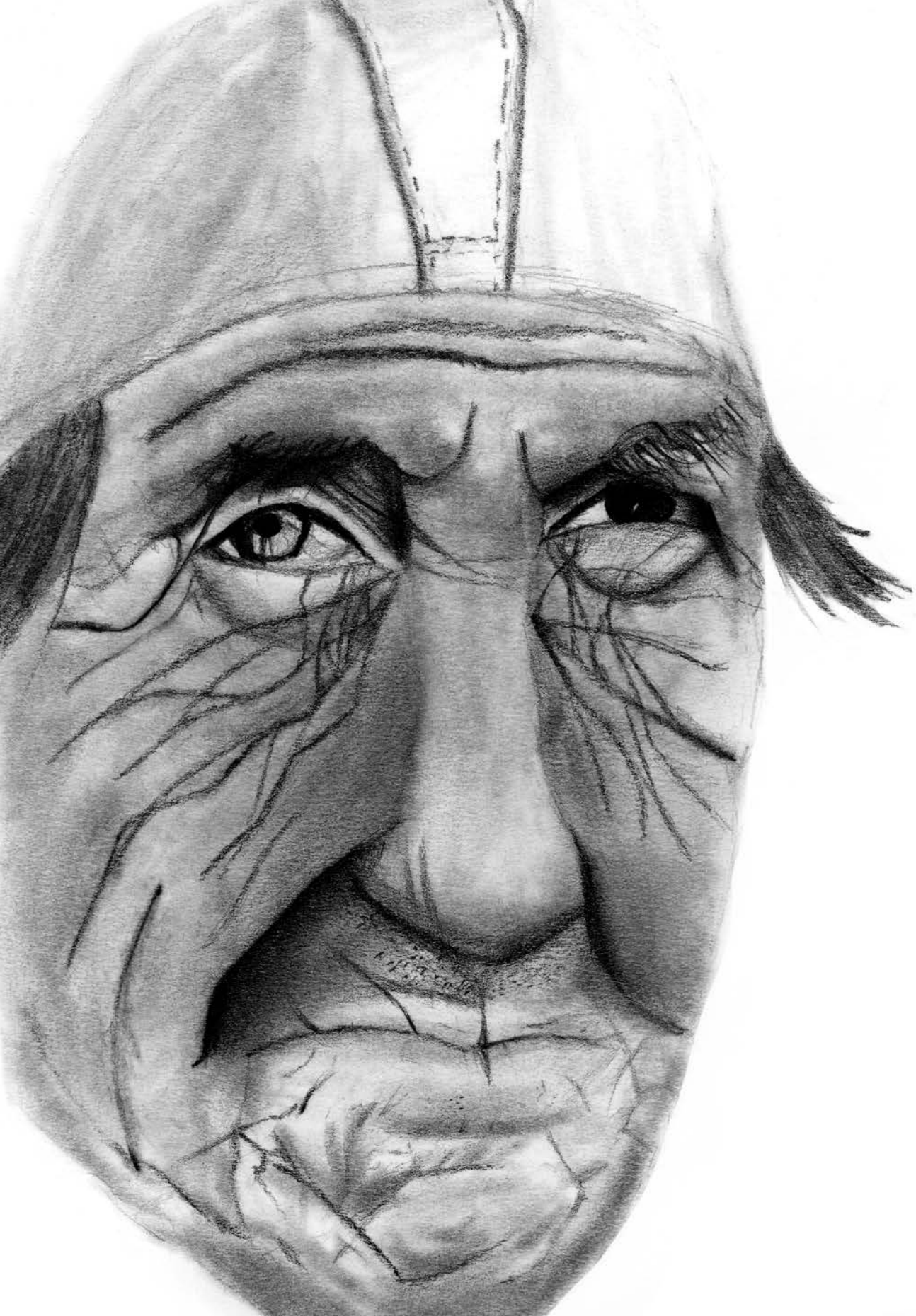
Write a story or poem inspired by 12-year-old Charlie Watkins-Ratcliffe's incredible artwork in Toitoi 13.
