Discussion Questions

1. Read Matthew 26:57–68. Summarize the events taking place. What stands out to you?
2. Consider how Jesus interacts with His accusers. What qualities or characteristics define Jesus? In what ways are those qualities countercultural?
3. Why or how can Jesus remain calm while his accusers become increasingly irate?
4. Think about the sermon. What was its main point and/or supporting points?
5. How could that point inform your thoughts, emotions, and behaviors? What small change will you make this week to align with the truth of God's Word?
6. If you asked a friend or coworker, "Who is Jesus?" how would they reply? In what ways is your answer different from theirs? How could you share that answer graciously?
