

THE JOURNEY

- The Rally. The Sail Malaysia Passage to Langkawi refers to the Malaysian leg of the Sail Indonesia/Sail2Indonesia-Sail Malaysia yacht rally.
- Cruise Marine Tourism Association of Malaysia.
 By joining Sail Malaysia you will also become an associate member by default. The objective of this association is to provide a feedback system between visiting yachts and the government agencies of Malaysia. Members also enjoy the many rally incentives/discounts provided over the course of your rally.
- Planning Your Journey. Once you register with us in you will also receive the Sail Malaysia Cruising Guidebook containing useful information about the rally destinations. A textonly version is also available in our website www.sailmalaysia.life
- Communication. Whatsapp group, emails and our website will be the main form of communication.
- Marina Berthing. All yachts are required to communicate directly with the marinas to confirm bookings.
- Event Format 1. Free and Easy although we encourage you to visit all the rally stops, you are free to pick and choose the stops that suit your schedule.
- Event Format 2. Yachts that complete the full rally (ie participating in all the rally stops) would be given a congratulatory gift at the end of the rally in Langkawi.

- Entering Malaysia. The Malaysian procedures for entry are fairly straightforward. Once you arrive in Puteri Harbour, the marina office will assist your clearing in with customs, immigration and harbour master, normally within the same day.
- Immigration (Visas). The majority of passport holders will have a 3 month visa issued on arrival. For details on Visa requirement by countries visit the Immigration website www.imi.gov.my. Passports will need to be valid for more than 6 months from the date of entry into Malaysia.
- Customs. Please observe that dangerous drugs (such as Morphine, heroin, opium, ganja) are prohibited from importation and exportation without the approval of the Ministry of Health, Malaysia.
- Health and Vaccination. A detailed overview of health considerations for travelers in Malaysia, can be found at www.mysafetrave.gov.my
- Medical needs. Public and private clinics and hospitals are abundant and affordable in Malaysia. Please check with the marina office for the one most convenient to you.
- Insurance. Sail Malaysia does not provide insurance for rally participants. Insurance covering medical or emergencies is recommended if you don't already have one.



Geography and People

Total Area: 329,750 sq km

Population: 32 million (2020 est.)

Ethnic Groups: Malay 50.4%. Chinese 23.7%.

Indigenous 11%, Indian 7.1%, Others 7.8% (2004 est.)

Religion: Islam 60.4% (Official Religion), Buddhist 19.2%. Christian 9.1%. Hindu 6.3%. Confucianism. Taoism, other traditional Chinese religions 2.6%, other or unknown 1.5%, none 0.8% (2000 census)

Languages spoken: Bahasa Malaysia (Official Language), English, Chinese (Cantonese, Mandarin, Hokkien, Hakka, Hainan, Foochow), Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Panjabi, Thai. In East Malaysia there are several indigenous languages; most widely spoken are Iban and Kadazan

Climate

Tropical: Hot and humid throughout the year. Annual winds: Southwest (April to October) and Northeast (October to February) monsoons

Currency

Only Malaysian Ringgit (MYR) is used. Money exhchange outlets are aplenty, especially around the rally stops. Credit cards are widely accepted (VISA, Mastercard, Diners, AMEX).

Mobile phones and internet services are excellent in this country. There are 3 major mobile phone companies which offer pre-paid phone and data cards if you are visiting temporarily - Maxis, Digi and Celcom. Nationwide broadband wireless access can be obtained for around RM 60-100 per month and you can typically gain access along the coastline. Most marinas offer the wireless service at nominal costs.

Provisioning

Food and beverage is not a problem in Malaysia. Western food and delicatessen are available in most towns and not expensive. Refueling is easily accessible in all the above rally destinations.

Dress Standards

Malaysia is a progressively developing nation with a strong conservative influence. Here, you will see a diverse range of dressing among its population from the Muslim women covered from head to toe to the modern western-influenced outfits. You are free to dress as you please in Malaysia. Smart casual clothes are ideal when going out in public places. When visiting government offices and religious sites (mosques, temples, etc.) we recommend that you dress modestly and men to wear long trousers.
