- 4. **Proverbs 9:10** says that "the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom". What does it mean to fear God, and why is that the starting place for true wisdom?
- 5. Share about a "valley" moment or season in your life. How did God's wisdom help you through it?

- 6. **Read 1 Corinthians 1:20-24.** Why is "Christ crucified" foolishness to the world in which we live? How is it a stumbling block for the religious?
- 7. **Read James 1:5.** What promise is embedded in this passage? What are some means through which God might give us His wisdom?
- 8. The life of Jesus is the perfect example of Godly wisdom. What sorts of practices did Jesus have that showed that wisdom?
- 9. Share one area of your life that you feel is lacking wisdom. What are a few action steps you can take to get God's wisdom in this area?
- 10. If wisdom is discerning and following God's ways, then folly is forgetting God's path and instead choosing sin. With that in mind, describe the difference between a wise life and a foolish one.
