TRIBULATION TO TRIUMPH

READ Revelation 22:6-21.

- 1. What or who comes to mind when you hear the word "trustworthy"? What makes Revelation different from the latest thing you read on the internet?
- 2. How many times do you see the word "soon" in this passage? What is the significance of that? Do you find yourself living as though you believe those words?
- 3. What is the benefit to holding to the message of Revelation according to this passage?
- 4. John is so overwhelmed by the incredible goodness and beauty of what we have in store that he was going to worship at the feet of the messenger. What are some ways in which our own worship can take the wrong focus?
- 5. What does it mean that Jesus is the Alpha & Omega? We may think of that broadly which is a true application, but how can it also be personal for us as Christ followers (Hebrews 12:2)?

6. What was the consequence of Adam & Eve's rebellion against God in **Genesis 3:22-24**? What changes in **Revelation 22:14**? What is meant by those who "wash their robes"?

7. In Revelation, we see what was broken in the garden of Eden restored. Our relationship with God is reconciled. The curse is eradicated and everything is good. We see those that have rejected Jesus will not experience this hope. How should such a reality compel our faithfulness and evangelism now?

8. How does Jesus satisfy our thirst? What were Jesus' words to the Samaritan woman in **John 4:13-14**? What is the invitation to the thirsty in verse 17?

9. What is John's response to Jesus' promise in verse 20? Can you currently say the same thing as John? Why or why not?

10. What are the big takeaways that you have from our study of Revelation? Have you seen Revelation in a new light? If so, how? How many of you would say that Revelation is more encouraging than you realized? If so, how?
