



Travelling to away games – Code of Conduct

Introduction

As a club, we provide buses to underage players to away games as part of the membership policy. Where this is availed of, there are expectations of coaches and players who use the buses. This document sets out the requirements of coaches for impacted teams.

Club Policy

It is the clubs policy that all areas below are fully adhered to and any amendments are done with the full written agreement of the management committee only.

For teams to avail of the buses:

- There must always be a minimum of one coach present on the bus
- The coach is the club representative and therefore should monitor the behaviour of all players ensuring that they
 - o Follow any instruction from the driver
 - o Remain seated throughout the journey
 - o Wear seatbelts where available and when appropriate
 - o Always behave in a respectful manner
 - o Coaches should adhere to the Code of Conduct and Best Practices set out in https://www.fai.ie/sites/default/files/atoms/files/FAI_code_of_conduct_for_coaches.pdf
 - o Expectation is that any behaviour by a player that is not acceptable would be informed to the parent/guardian and where necessary/appropriate advised to the club
