

## <u>Overview</u> Transition Year Programme

- Open Year Programme taken after Junior Cycle before the two-year Leaving Certificate Programme
- Designed to act as a bridge between J.C. and L.C. programmes.
- Optional for students
- Programme is designed by the school to suit the needs and interests of the students
- No State Examination
- Assessment is carried out on an ongoing basis
- Ran by a Core Team





#### <u>Aims</u> Transition Year Programme


- To develop an awareness of personal dignity and to foster mutual respect and sensitivity towards others
- To be inspired by the vision of Nano Nagle which shows special concern for the disadvantaged and is committed to promoting a just society
- To develop life skills that will best prepare them for the world of work and community involvement beyond their school years
- To experience a year where emphasis is placed on **personal responsibility**
- To participate in the programme as creative, caring, reflective, articulate and self confident individuals



#### <u>Aims</u> Transition Year Programme

- To engage in self-directed and independent learning by developing a self-efficacy of their own educational needs
- To broaden students' educational experiences and social awareness beyond the classroom in practical situations, within a safe working environment
- To be guided in making **informed decisions** about future education and careers
- To experience a broad range of teaching and learning methodologies and strategies
- To be prepared for a smooth transition from Junior Cycle to **Senior Cycle**
