Life Group Questions to consider:

- Read John 6:1-15. What motivated the huge crowds to follow Jesus wherever he went? What sign did the crowd that gathered see Jesus do? What conclusion did the crowd reach after seeing that sign? What was the crowd intending to do in response?
- 2. Read John 6:16-21. What sign did the disciples experience during the night? Do you think they comprehended the significance of that miracle? Why or why not?
- 3. Read John 6:26-34 What does Jesus say motivates the crowds' seeking of him? What does Jesus say should be their motivation?
- 4. How does Jesus answer their question, "What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God?"
- 5. Read 6:35-42. Note some of the things Jesus says about himself in this response. What is the crowd's response to what Jesus says?
- 6. Read 6:43-60. What do you think made this sermon "a difficult statement" (vs. 60) for this crowd? Review your lists of the things Jesus said about himself in this sermon. Which one is most difficult for you to hear and accept?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
