Life Group Questions to consider:

- 1. Read James 12-4 Do you feel like you handle suffering well?
- 2. Do you have a hard time seeing God at work in the midst of your suffering?
- 3. Is there a time you would like to share where you recognized your personal sin was the cause of a hard situation? What was the outcome?
- 4. Who in the account do you most identify with and why?
 - a. The Neighbors who were confused and had question.
 - b. The Parents So paralyzed by fear they were unwilling to stand up and testify to the goodness of Jesus?
 - c. The Pharisees Who were so concerned with following rules and laws that they not only missed the miracle but the Messiah himself.
 - d. The Blind Man- Had faith that transcended his circumstances, chose to believe and worship Jesus?
- 5. Do you sometimes feel your pain and suffering are outside the realm of God's sovereignty?
- 6. Are we eager to share the good news of what Jesus has done for us? If not why not?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
