Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Who are your heroes? In what ways do you long to connect with glory greater than yourself?
2. Exodus 1:1-7 describes God's people greatly increasing in number. Why does God choose to multiply His people?
3. In Exodus 1:8-14, the Egyptians see the growth of the Israelites as a threat and try to stop them. When is it easy for you to be self-focused and miss how God might be working?
4. Exodus 1:15-22 shows Shiphrah and Puah obeying God rather than the king of Egypt. How do you respond when opposition to following God increases? When is it right to oppose authority?
5. How is God challenging you this week to trust Him and His way in spite of opposition?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.

Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
