MOSES | 6.1.2023

Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Have you ever broken a promise? Has anyone ever broken a promise to you? How does your experience with broken promises affect your view of God's promises?
2. Exodus 2:1-10 introduces Moses as an important individual in God's plan for His people. Why does God work His promise both personally in Moses and communally in Israel?
3. In Exodus 2:11-15, Moses encounters difficulty causing him to flee. What problems may be associated with God's promise today?
4. Moses is in a period of waiting in Exodus 2:16-22. When have you experienced a season requiring patience with God's promise?
5. In Exodus 2:23-25, God hears, sees, and takes notice of His people crying out for help. How would it look to fully trust that God remembers you along with His promise?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
