Life Group Questions to consider:

- God is consistent throughout Scripture. How does Exodus 11:1-10 compare to the New Testament in consistently keeping His promises?
- 2. The details of the Passover event are outlined in Exodus 12:1-13. Why does God call his people to actively participate?
- 3. In Exodus 12:21-36, we see how God fulfills His promises, executes His plan, and redeems His people. How are you convicted, challenged, and comforted by His redemptive plan?
- 4. Exodus 13:17-22 shows us how God leads His people with His presence. How does God lead His people today?
- 5. How will you actively participate in God's plan as part of His people this week? How will you faithfully "go under" His authority?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
