Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Where do you typically search for wisdom? What sources of wisdom has God provided in your life?
2. In Exodus 18:1-12, Moses functions in a community context with his father-in-law Jethro and the elders of Israel. How does your community provide the context for growing in God's wisdom?
3. Jethro observes Moses' struggles and offers some solutions in Exodus 18:13-23, including delegation and discerning God's will. How are you applying God's wisdom by delegating and discerning?
4. Exodus 18:24-27 shows Moses getting active and following the wise counsel he received from Jethro. How is God prompting you to actively obey His wisdom?
5. Every Christian is called as a disciple and called to make disciples. Who is currently discipling you? Who is currently being disciplined by you?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.

Now go and take your next step. Go and BE the Church.
