Life Group Questions to consider:

- 1. What's the difference between relevant and relatable? How is God's Word both relevant and relatable? Why are both important?
- 2. Exodus 14:1-4 describes how God will be honored by what's about to happen. Why is God always concerned with His glory?
- 3. In Exodus 14:5-14, we see relatable pictures of Pharaoh, the Israelites, and Moses. How do you see yourself in each of them?
- 4. God parts the Red Sea, saves His people, and defeats their enemies in Exodus 14:15-31. What does this action reveal about God and His power?
- 5. Moses leads the Israelite people in a song in Exodus 15:1-21, telling of God's greatness. How will your life sing the relevant and relatable message of God's glory in Jesus Christ this week?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
