Life Group Questions to consider:

1. How have you experienced the tension between being made for covenant and living in a broken-promise world?
2. In Exodus 19:1-6, God promises that the Israelites will be His special possession, and He says the same thing about the church in 1 Peter 2:9-10. What are the conditions that must be met to fulfill God's covenant promise?
3. Exodus 19:7-17 describes the requirements and boundaries for the Israelites to meet God at Sinai. In what ways is God's presence terrifying? How is the fear of the Lord potentially undesirable yet still good?
4. The Lord visits Sinai in Exodus 19:18-25. How does the presence of God demonstrate His faithfulness?
5. What is the better covenant that Jesus guarantees in Hebrews 7:22? How do you need to stop trusting in your ability to fulfill that covenant? How will you trust in His calling you to His completed covenant?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
